

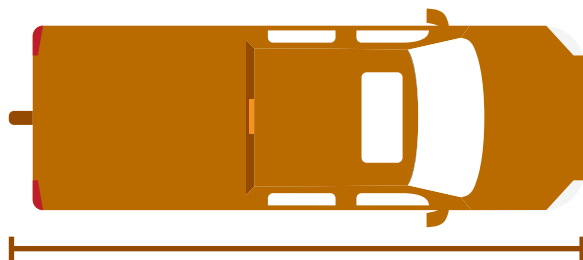


# Single Vehicle Size Limits

## on the Zion-Mt. Carmel Highway

The historic Zion-Mt. Carmel Highway was built nearly 100 years ago, and it was designed for much smaller vehicles than we have today. The following limits were established in order to maintain safe, sustainable travel for all visitors.

**Vehicles cannot exceed any of the following measurements:**



**Length**

**35' - 9"**  
(10.9 m)



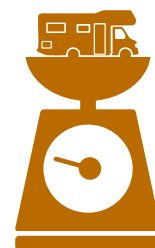
**Width**

**7' - 10"**  
(2.39 m)



**Height**

**11' - 4"**  
(3.45 m)



**Weight**

**50,000 lbs**  
(22,680 kg)

*Measurements include mirrors, tires, and attachments such as AC units, bike racks, satellite dishes, or other after-market modifications.*

*Vehicles that exceed these measurements cannot drive the Zion-Mt. Carmel Highway. Large vehicles must turn around at Canyon Junction or the East Entrance.*

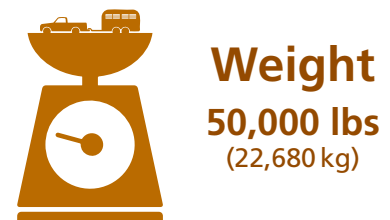
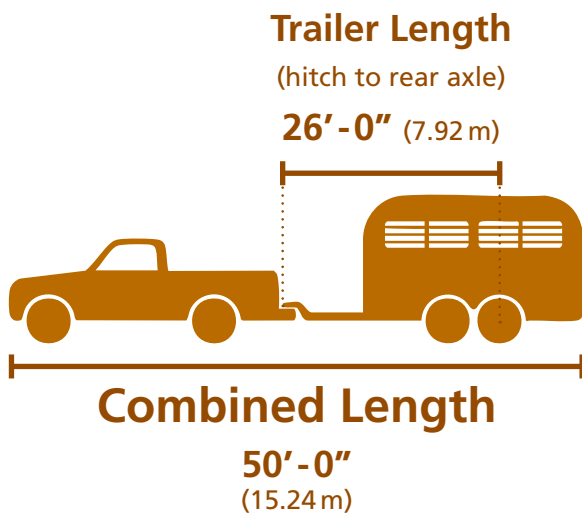


# Combined Vehicle Size Limits

## on the Zion-Mt. Carmel Highway

A combined vehicle is any motor vehicle configuration made up of two or more separate units that are physically connected at a pivot point and operate together (for example, a truck with a trailer).

**Vehicles cannot exceed any of the following measurements:**



*Measurements include mirrors, tires, and attachments such as AC units, bike racks, satellite dishes, or other after-market modifications.*

*Vehicles that exceed these measurements cannot drive the Zion-Mt. Carmel Highway. Large vehicles must turn around at Canyon Junction or the East Entrance.*
